PARK POINT BEACH HOUSE

The Park Point Beach House is the large, enclosed building on top of the sand dunes. It has indoor plumbing, bathrooms, electricity, and limited kitchen accommodations.



PAVILIONS

The Pavilions are the open-air picnic shelters found in most city parks in Duluth. They are equipped with electricity and include the use of grills. Pavilions are first-come, first-served, unless one obtains a permit for an exclusive use reservation. The Park Point Rec Area has two Pavilions.
